

## ANTI-SEMITISM

The Almighty God of Heaven and Earth chose Israel as the nation through whom the whole counsel of God would be imparted and released as a blessing to the whole earth. The Patriarchs who are the fathers of God's work in man were all established in Israel. Through Israel, He blessed the earth with His Commandments and His Word, and through Israel, He chose to take the form of a Jewish man who would give His life for the sins of the whole world. The Covenant and the promises were given to Israel, and through the Jewish King Jesus, we as Gentiles are grafted into Israel and get to partake of the fat of their root (Rom. 11:17).

"Theirs is the adoption as sons; theirs the divine glory, the covenants, the receiving of the law, the temple worship and the promises. Theirs are the patriarchs, and from them is traced the human ancestry of Christ, who is God over all, forever praised! Amen." Romans 9:4-5 NIV

Anti-Semitism is in essence rebellion against God's will and is the anti-Christ spirit of Satan himself. It is a spirit that has become deeply rooted in the psyche of man throughout the nations of the world. This phenomenon exists in every nation because wherever there is rebellion against God, a covenant of agreement is entered into with Satan, the one who hates the nation of Israel and the Jewish people.

In seeking to preserve his rule and reign on earth, Satan's fierce determination is to remove any possibility of the return of the Jewish King Jesus, whose feet will once again stand on the soil of Israel from where His Kingdom will be administered (Is. 2:3, Zech14:6). Jesus' return signals the end of Satan's diabolic reign and his malevolent plan is to inspire all nations and peoples to turn against the Jewish people, destroy the nation of Israel altogether and prevent the return of Christ.

God declared in His word that if we choose to bless His people Israel, we would be blessed and partake of the His covenant with Israel and corresponding blessings through Jesus. He also pronounced a curse on all who hate, persecute, and reject Israel, and therefore reject the blessings of Israel provided for them, "I will bless those who bless you, And I will curse him who curses you; and in you [Israel] all the families of the earth shall be blessed" (Gen 12:3).

In Deuteronomy chapters 28 to 30, God offered Israel the choice to be extravagantly blessed (36 blessings) through obedience to His commands, or to fall under a curse (169 curses) if they chose the path of rebellion. He also decreed that these *very same curses* would come upon all the nations who chose to curse and persecute Israel.

"I make this covenant and this oath, not with you alone, but with him who stands here with us today before the LORD our God, as well as with him who is not here with us today..." Deuteronomy 29:14

"Also the LORD your God will put all these curses on your enemies and on those who hate you, who persecuted you." Deuteronomy 30:7



Anti-Semitism can be traced throughout history and the generational lines through most cultures, nations, and religions of the world. In World Wars I and II most nations took their stand against Israel which has continued to this very day through the United Nations. Most Religions, in their history, including the Roman Catholic Church, the Lutheran Church, and the Anglican Church, all took part in persecuting the Jewish people, some in horrific ways.

Over one hundred cities or nations have expelled the Jewish people from their land since A.D. 250, including, France, Germany, England, Hungary, Switzerland, Belgium, Italy, Spain, Portugal, Ukraine, Russia, and all Arab nations to name a few. Before Christ—B.C., Most empires conquered and persecuted the Jewish people from the time God gave birth to Israel as a nation. Both North and South America is comprised of people who came from Europe and other nations of the world – most people of the world are therefore from an ancestry line that has persecuted the Jewish people in some way, whether through their religion, their nation, or both, and therefore fall under these generational curses (see Number 14:18 Jdg. 6:25-26).

## **Cleansing Prayer for Anti-Semitism**

(Based on Deuteronomy 28)

O Lord God of Heaven, great and awesome God who keeps His covenant of unfailing love with those who love Him and obey His commands (Neh. 1). Lord, you have chosen Israel to be a blessing to the nations of the world; they have paid the tremendous cost to give the world Your Word, Your commandments and ordinances, the revelation of Your Awesome Majesty, and they have suffered the travail to birth Your Son, the King of Kings and Lord of Lords—Jesus Christ. God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob; Lord, You whose mercy endures forever, I and my forefathers have sinned against you and Your people Israel.

Lord, You said to Abraham, the father of Isaac and Israel, "I will bless those who bless you, and I will curse those who curse you." You said through Moses Your servant that You would inflict all the curses written in Deuteronomy 28 on Israel's enemies, and on those who hate and persecute Israel (Deut. 30:17).

Father God, I confess the sin of Anti-Semitism in my generational line, I confess that we have persecuted, mocked, and cursed Your chosen people Israel.

Lord, I and my forefathers have rebelled and not obeyed Your Word to bless Your people and to pray for their peace, but have chosen to disobey your command to bless Israel and have cursed them with our judgments and the curses of our mouths; so now the solemn curses and judgments written in the law of Moses, the servant of God, have come upon us because we sinned against your people Israel.

Lord the forefathers of most nations have been found guilty of this anti-Semitic, anti-Christ spirit. Lord, I and my forefathers have allowed the Anti-Christ spirit that hates Your Son Jesus, to use us to persecute Your Son and inflict the worst horrors on Your people Israel. Lord the blood of Your son Israel cries out from the land of the nations of the earth; forgive us for defiling the land with this most terrible and grievous sin.



Lord the fathers of the gentile church, birthed through Your Jewish Son Jesus, have sinned against Your people Israel, from its conception. Lord the fathers of the Roman Catholic Church, and the fathers of the Protestant, Lutheran, and Anglican churches have committed grave sins of persecution, exile, murder, and torture against your people Israel. O Lord the fathers of the gentile church have sinned against Your sons and daughters of Israel throughout history and in most nations even to this very day. O Merciful God we are covered in shame for our many sins and crimes against your people.

Lord, You said in Your Word that Your people Israel would be in the midst of many peoples like showers on the grass. Lord forgive us and all our ancestors from Spain, Portugal, Italy, Hungary, Austria, Lithuania, Russia, Ukraine, France, Germany, England, all Arab nations, and all 109 cities and nations throughout the centuries who have exiled your people from land you placed them in as dew, to be a blessing, and left them homeless and destitute (Mic.5:7). O Lord forgive our sin!

Lord, in persecuting your son Israel we have persecuted your Jewish Son Jesus—the Lion of the tribe of Judah, who will return to establish His Kingdom on earth, as the Jewish King of Israel, whose center is Jerusalem (Zech 14:6, Is, 2:3).

You have declared that Your Law shall go forth from Zion. Forgive us Lord for attempting to usurp their place of honor in Your kingdom. You declared Jerusalem to be an immovable rock and a heavy stone, that any who try to move it would be injured; forgive us and our forefathers for attempting to move Jerusalem's place of honor and replace it with Rome, Constantinople, St. Petersburg and with England (Zech. 12).

O Lord, You are gracious and merciful and anxious to pardon those who love you when we confess our sins, ask your forgiveness, repent and turn from our wicked way (Ps. 86:15).

O Lord, I come before Your Throne of Mercy and ask for Your forgiveness, Your pardon, and Your cleansing from my sin and the sins of my fathers and all bloodguilt. We stand under the shadow of the Cross and plead the Blood of your Son Jesus.

When Jesus became a curse for us on the Cross, He nailed all decrees and the written requirements against us to the Cross and made a public spectacle and open show of Satan. Because all our sins including our sin against the Jewish people, were nailed to the Cross, I ask that You pardon me and my family today and break all curses that have come upon us because of anti-Semitism.

**I renounce** the sin of antisemitism and choose to embrace Israel, the apple of Your eye, Your special treasure. I choose to bless and honor them as the patriarchs, the fathers of Your Church, to whom belong the Shekinah Glory, the covenants, the Law, and the Promises (Rom. 9:4).

**Cleanse me** O Lord, and in your mercy, wash the stain of this sin from my life and the lives of my children, and my children's children. Lord, I ask that you would in your awesome might and power, please cleanse all land of any nation defiled by myself or my ancestors to a thousand generations from the sin of anti-Semitism and all the evil it has produced. Lord, I plead the blood of Jesus over all defiled land and break all ties to defiled land today.

Lord remove the root from my family line and break the power of the sin of anti-Semitism over our lives today, and in Your great mercy and grace cancel the curses you pronounced on those who curse, persecute, or harm Your chosen people.

Lord, in Your great might, Break the power of the curse on the fruit of the womb and of barrenness; the curse on our going out and coming in.



Break the power of the curse of confusion and the rebuke on everything we put our hand to until we are destroyed and come to sudden ruin.

Break the power of the curse of a bronze sky over our head and the iron ground beneath us. Lord break the curse of being defeated by our enemies and Yours.

Break the power of the curse of failure, oppression, and robbery from our lives with no one to rescue. Break the curse of being the tail and not the head, of others lending to us but not being able to lend to others. Break the curse of debt and financial lack.

Lord, break the power of the curse of not being able to possess our harvest and keep it;

Break the power of the curse of disease, infirmity, and sickness, wasting disease, fever, inflammation, boils, tumors, scurvy and itch, and diseases that cannot be cured. Incurable boils on legs and knees and from head to foot, severe and lingering diseases, and prolonged disasters.

Break the power of the curse of an anxious mind, madness, blindness, panic, and tragedy, eyes weary with longing and a despairing heart.

Break the power of the curse of defeat by our enemies.

Break the power of the curse of oppression, robbery, and loss.

Break the power of the curse of slavery of my natural and spiritual children to their enemies and the yoke of captivity on their lives.

Break the power of the curse of being exiled on my generational line.

Break the power of the curse of mockery, ridicule, and horror from my life and the life of my family.

Break the power of the curse of disease on the produce of our land.

Break the power of the iron yoke of oppression from our neck.

Break the power of the curse of devouring our sons and daughters.

Break the power of the curse of a cold heart and lack of love in our family.

Break the power of the curse of plagues and unbearable sickness and all diseases.

Break the power of the curse of poor eyesight, trembling heart, a despairing soul, and fear.

Lord by faith I now release myself from the grip of all demonic curses and command them to be gone now and forever from my life.

By faith, I now stand under the shadow of the Cross and claim the Power in the Blood of Jesus that was shed for me, I am cleansed, washed, and sanctified by the Blood of Jeshua and His forgiveness of my sin.

**I now declare** myself and my family to a thousand generations loosed from the spirit of anti-Semitism—the spirit of anti-Christ, and all accompanying curses through Jesus' victory and triumph at the cross.

By faith, I now remove myself from the tainted bloodline of my ancestors and place myself and my children under the protection of the Blood of Jeshua, our Messiah. Lord, I ask that You remove, by Your Great Power, every trace of the anti-Semitic influence from my thinking processes, that the demonic veil covering my eyes concerning Israel would be removed, that I may see clearly and think righteously according to Your



Word. Today I choose to bless Israel, I declare that their people are my people, and their God is My God (Ruth1:16).

Lord, I choose obedience to Your Word to be a blessing to Israel and to pray for the peace of Jerusalem until You make her a praise in the earth. Thank You, LORD for the Blood that cleanses me. Amen
